Notes on the instruments: The bagpipe is a Swedish bagpipe - not Scottish and thus not particularly loud! The volume is more in comparison to a fiddle. The Nyckelharpa is a bowed instrument which uses sympathetic strings that create a very resonant sound, rich in reverb. This is an acoustical trait of the instrument and can't be turned off (short of removing the strings...)!
